What to bring

Other than your classic camping gear we ask that you bring a few extra things to make your time with us enjoyable!

- Water Gun(s) (We plan to hold a water war, so please bring a water gun to participate)
- Tiki Torch(s) (These will be used during our friendship fire and can be purchased from the dollar store)
- WATER!! There will be NO onsite water, so please bring your own water unless you wish to walk long distances to access a spigot.

Important Info

- There will be no water access close by. Please bring in your own water unless you wish to haul water across Camp Samac
- Directions will be available to groups requiring food supplies throughout the weekend.
- There are lots of grocery stores and fast food venues within 3 kms of the campsite.
- Cars will **not be** allow to stay in the camping area but must be left at the parking lot. You will have to carry your gear for up to 5 minutes to your campsite, so pack accordingly.
- There are no designated campfire pits in the camping area of the Moot.
- No picnic tables will be available, please bring your own tables and chairs. Unfortunately our site does not have picnic tables.
